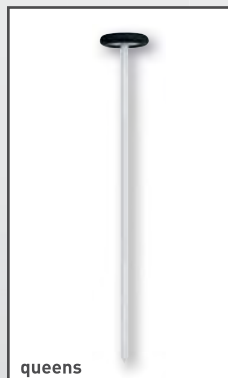


# Percussion Hammers
