LIFEVAC - Eliminating Choking Tragedies

Choking is the 4th leading cause of accidental death in children under 5 years old. One person dies every 5 days from these tragic deaths.

LifeVac is an option if protocol fails. This non-invasive airway clearance apparatus is designed to remove a foreign body obstruction when standard choking protocol has been followed without success. The patented designed valve prevents air from pushing an object or food downward. On the downward compression all air is vented outside the unit, and not into the victim's airway. When the unit is pulled back, negative pressure is generated and it dislodges the obstruction.





